

## Cambodia Itinerary



Day 1: Arrive at Future Light Orphanage outside of Phnom Penh. The group will live at the orphanage with the 230+ young residents for the next 4 nights.

Day 2 – 4: Opportunities for more shopping and outings as a group and with the kids when they're not in class.

Farewell evening party (also the children's June Birthday Party) will be highlighted by a fantastic event of traditional "Khmer" dances performed by the talented young dancers at FLOW and group dance party.



Day 5: After walking the children to school in the morning the group will move to a hotel in the heart of Phnom Penh's active riverfront. The rest of the day is free for shopping and relaxing. An option is to spend the afternoon with some of the children at the Cambodian Children's Fund, founded in 2002 by Scott Neeson. More detail upon request.



Day 6: Drive by bus to Siem Reap which allows time for rest and a view of the countryside. Check into the Bopha Angkor Hotel for the next 3 nights.

Day 7: Group event to enjoy sunrise at Angkor Wat. Daytime options for touring: guided group tour, individual exploration, 20-minute hot air balloon ride with view of Angkor Wat and the countryside. Group will visit two of Airline Ambassadors' sponsored pump wells along the road, and the Angkor Wat to Banteay Srei (temple of women). Afternoon free for shopping at the old market and other sightseeing.



Day 8: Village visit where we will see the New Hope Community Centre, a safe house for girls and women jeopardy of trafficking and forced prostitution in Mondul 3 village. The group will reunite with 3 yr old Somnang, a little girl

Airline Ambassadors volunteers rescued and brought to the centre on the last visit to Cambodia.

Team farewell dinner, and close.
