Your itinerary:

Day 1: Meet your Airline Ambassador mission coordinator at the departure airport in the United States. Travel 3 hours by air to Managua, the capital of Nicaragua. Board a comfortable coach bus, where you will be greeted by Armando, our driver and tour guide, for the mission. Travel deep into Nicaragua to the remote village of Somoto nestled between a beautiful lush green landscape and coffee plantations. Settle into Hotel Portal de Angel. The name explains it all. Enjoy a warm meal highlighting local Nicaraguan cuisine. Settle in for a good nights sleep.

Day 2: Wake up to an amazing breakfast of your choice topped off by a delicious cup of hot Nicaraguan coffee. Enjoy the beautiful quaint atmosphere of the hotel while sipping your fresh coffee. Travel to the first project site at the Airline Ambassadors adopted project, Mon Senor Jose de Carmen Suezo Primary school. We will be delivering aid in the form of school supplies and building materials to the school. Spend the morning painting classrooms. Enjoy lunch with the children of the school. Return to the hotel for an evening of relaxation before indulging in a hot meal at a typical local restaurant. Team meeting, share your experiences with your AAI team members. Settle in for an evening of sweet dreams.



Day 3: Wake up to a hot breakfast, sip your coffee and wonder..... How is Coffee produced? Airline Ambassadors will take you deep into the mountains of Nicaragua to visit a remote coffee plantation. Meet the family of farmers that grow and maintain a coffee crop on the mountainside high above Somoto. Hike into the tropical forest to experience and participate in growing and harvesting a coffee crop. Learn how coffee is grown, harvested and then exported to your local grocery store. This is a rare educational experience. Bring your hiking boots! Relaxing dinner while reminiscing about the day

Day 4: Breakfast. Head to the Canyon for a day of fun. Enjoy whitewater rafting, cliff diving or simply swim in the river. Enjoy a riverside picnic with typical Nicaraguan music before boarding the bus to head to Managua. Arrive Las Mercedes Resort in Managua. Enjoy an arrival dinner, and settle in for the night.



Day 5: Breakfast. Relax by the pool for the day, or take an afternoon trip to one of the largest artisan markets in Managua. Buy your local handmade crafts before heading home the next day.

Day 6: Breakfast and prepare for departure to the United States.
